### <NOTES>

- 1 Welcome Assembly: an assembly held to welcome the freshmen and to familiarize them with new school life and events by showing them videos
- 2 Installation of Executive Members of Student Council: a ceremony in which the newly elected students are installed as the executive members of the student council by the principal
- 3 Intramural Ball Game Matches: a school event in which all the students enjoy ball game matches, such as volleyball and soccer, as members of their class for the purpose of promoting friendliness among classmates
- 4 Student Assembly: an assembly at which all the students discuss the basic policy of the student council
- 5 Intramural Chorus Competition: a school event in which all the classes perform choruses and compete with each other to strengthen their mutual friendship
- 6 Volunteer Social Service Work: a program for students to volunteer to visit welfare facilities, such as nursing homes, and do some social service work; e.g. cleaning rooms and weeding gardens
- 7 Training Camp for Club Members: an event in which some club members stay at a training facility or a summer resort to practice intensively, to improve their skills, and to unite them more closely
- 8 Culture Festival: a school event in which all the classes and some of the cultural clubs do some stage performances, or exhibit their members' works of art, research papers, etc.
- 9 Appreciation of Arts Performance: a school event in which the whole school appreciates musical or theatrical performances
- 10 Intramural *Hyakunin-isshu* Competition: an event in which all the classes compete with each other in the game of *Hyakunin-isshu*, a card game in which the players try to match the first and second halves of each of the One Hundred *Tanka* Poems by One Hundred Celebrated Poets
- 11 Walking Rally: a school event in which some third-year students volunteer to walk around the city to commemorate their graduation
